SIX Index Licensing, 2024

Guideline – Licensing Terms

Data license is required

- Active portfolio management activities: pure internal use of the licensed content for active asset management, including portfolio management, asset allocation, risk assessment, performance attribution and all related fund accounting activities, e.g. NAV calculation, annual accounts, etc.
- In this case, the product is not linked to a SIX index. It can be referred to such index, but the performance of the index should be clearly beaten. The differentiation criteria in this case is the outperformance of a specific index by the corresponding product
- The aim of the product (i.e. investment goal) is to exceed/outperform the performance of the referenced index. The goal cannot be to match the performance of the index

Guideline – Licensing Terms

Product license is required

- Any financial market instrument issued or created based on or otherwise related to SIX indices. The wording «or otherwise related to SIX indices» is very broad and must therefore be interpreted broadly
- It is crucial that the performance of the index forms the basis for the performance of the product
- If the aim of the product (i.e. investment goal) is to outperform the referenced index, it can no longer be considered a passive product, as active investment decisions are necessary to achieve a different performance
- The implementation of the investments within a portfolio is not relevant for the determination of a passive product
