As announced in <u>SIX Exfeed Message No. 06/2024</u>, the SWXess Maintenance Release (SMR14) will be introduced with a staged approach.

Please be advised that the SMR14 Membertest stage 1 migration weekend will take place **from 13 to 14 September 2024 with go live on Monday, 16 September 2024**.

#### **Migration Schedule**

The migration to SMR14 Membertest stage 1 will start on Thursday, 12 September 2024 after "End of Business" and will be finished on Saturday, 14 September 2024 at approximately 16:30 CEST.

Fri 13 September 2024	All day	Upgrade SWXess Trading Platform to include SMR14 <b>Membertest stage 1</b> functionality.
	Approx. 16:30	Confirmation will be published on the system status page in the Member Section (and MSC Alert for Subscribers) that the upgrade has been completed.
	Following confirmation until 20:00	SWXess systems are running, connectivity is possible, however markets are closed and orders/quotes will be rejected.
Sat 14 September 2024	11:00 – 20:00	SWXess systems are running, connectivity is possible, however markets are closed and orders/quotes will be rejected.
Sun 15 September 2024	All day	Contingency Day. SWXess systems are closed, SCAP is available.
Mon 16 September 2024	As from 06:00	First trading day on SMR14 in Membertest environment (M01) with stage 1 functionality.
